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CERTIFICATE IN BIBLICAL STUDIES

This program is designed for the individual who desires a basic understanding of Biblical truths and sufficient Biblical understanding so as to be of assistance to the pastor of his/her church in the various ministries offered by the church (e.g. Sunday School). The course of study may be completed within one and a half years, depending on the number of credit hours taken each term.

The Certificate of Biblical Studies degree is designed to prepare students to assume positions of leadership and to upgrade the skills and knowledge of persons presently in ministry. The program combines a solid foundation in Biblical and religious-related courses with a sound arts component.
